Helping is a fantastic way to meet people or to see what happens at a competition before you try it yourself. No specialist knowledge is needed to help build jump courses, pick up poles or read the draw list of entries as showjumping steward. You can learn a huge amount by pen-cilling for one of our knowledgeable and friendly dressage or showjumping judges. If you do have specialist knowledge or experience, helping is an opportunity to pass on that knowledge and put something back into the sport you love.

You can help for a day, half a day or as little as an hour. The most important thing is you commit in advance so the phase head can schedule you in. And of course you must turn up. We track cumulative helping hours in our database so we can recognise our top helpers and spread the helping load across all members

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activities and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse sports activities.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the activities and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability as a result of my failure to comply.
