



Application for Bridle Numbers

All horses competing in dressage throughout the state should have a bridle number. It is compulsory for horses competing in all Official tests regardless of where the competition is held and recommended for Associate dressage competitions.

There are two options:

Option 1 – Riders/owners can request a bridle number to be allocated and can purchase a bridle number holder from a saddlery or have it embroidered on their competition saddlecloth. The bridle number is free. Riders can also phone Equestrian NSW on 02 9620 2660 to request their bridle number.

Option 2 – Riders/owners can request a set of 2 plastic bridle numbers for the cost of \$10 including postage.
